2.	49 CFR 383	CDL Standards, Requirements and Penalities
3.	49 CFR 385	Safety and Fitness
4.	49 CFR 387	Minimum Levels of Financial Responsibility
5.	49 CFR 390.5	Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations
6.	49 CFR 391	Qualification of Drivers
7.	49 CFR 392	Driving of Motor Vehicle
8.	49 CFR 393	Parts and Accessories
9.	49 CFR 395	Driver's Hours of Service
10.	49 CFR 396	Inspection, Repair, Maintenance

Take the time before the New Year to pick up that Federal Motor Carrier Safety Act in your truck or on your desk and read these 10 sections. By doing so, you will be ready for a happy and a safe New Year.
